~**TUITION IS DUE** on the first day of each month. Monthly invoices will be sent via e-mail as a reminder. A late tuition fee of \$5 per class will be charged on the 10th of each month. If tuition is more than one month in arrears the student will not be permitted to attend class until payment is received.

~**GOOD FAITH PAYMENT**: will be collected with registration. This GFP is credited to the family's May tuition payment if the family account is in "good standing" and the student's academic progress and behavior qualifies him/her for completion of the term.

~**PLEASE NOTE**: Students who **drop a class** will forfeit the Good Faith Payment for each class dropped as well as the month in which the drop occurs.

~A **5% PROCESSING FEE** is added to each monthly payment, beginning with the Good Faith Payment.

~**SUPPLY FEES** for each semester, as applicable, are established by each individual teacher and will be paid directly to them and not KEYS.

~**Academic Excellence** ~ Students are expected to be prepared for class, to be punctual and to attend all sessions scheduled unless previous arrangements have been made with the teacher. Acceptable academic progress is defined by a grade of A or B as determined by the KEYS course instructor. A grade of C is acceptable for those who are working to ability level. Upon request of the teacher, the parent will attend classes with the student in order to better assist at home if he/she has a C or below. KEYS' directors will maintain a list of students with poor academic progress. If your student struggles in any class, please do not hesitate to contact the teacher.

~ **The Academic Review Board** will automatically evaluate students with grades of a D or below to determine continuation in KEYS classes. A grade of C will be reviewed at the teacher's discretion. If the student is working to ability level, he/she is welcome to continue in the class. If the student is not working to potential, he/she will be allowed to remain in class for four (4) weeks in order to show acceptable improvement. **If progress is not demonstrated, the student will be dropped from the course with forfeiture of their Good Faith Payment and current month's tuition.**
