

We believe:

That the holy Bible is inerrant, composed of the Old and New Testaments, and is of final and supreme authority in faith and life. "All scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness so that we may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

That this faith should manifest itself in the service of love as set forth in the example of our Lord, to the end that the kingdom of God may come upon the earth.
