

KEYS Student Covenant 2022-23

I understand that KEYS classes are grounded in and taught from a biblical worldview and that, as a KEYS student, I desire to be mentored in the biblical worldview.

I agree to respect all authority and willingly submit to their guidance without complaint.

I agree to respect others' consciences, needs, and property (including the property of Centerpoint Community Church). I will put others above myself.

I agree to be self-governing. I will know the policies, exercise self-control, be under authority, be responsible for my own behavior, and accept the consequences of my behavior.

I agree to keep my peers accountable, not simply relying on adult intervention. When situations arise, I will try my best to resolve the issue with the person and encourage them to do the right thing. If the situation is not resolved, I will speak to an authority if someone is doing something wrong because I want the best for them in the long run.

I agree to come to class prepared with all required materials.

I agree to fulfill all responsibilities and turn my assignments in on time.

I agree not to cheat or plagiarize.

I agree to save socializing for a time after class.

I agree not to bring a computer, tablet, or other electronic devices on campus. If I carry a cell phone on campus, I will keep it powered off and out of sight from 8:00-5:30 and at other times as directed. If I need to call my parent, I will report to the KEYS office.

I agree to present myself in a morally sound and agreeable way in how I dress, how I act, and what I say.

I agree to be involved in the KEYS community, read the weekly Monday Memo, and attend monthly convocations if I am on campus.

I agree not to participate in inappropriate or romantic displays of affection (i.e., hugging, hand-holding, or kissing) and to respect the personal boundaries of others.

I agree not to use profane language or speak about things that do not honor the Lord.

I agree not to walk on or off-campus without an adult.

I agree to abide by all rules spelled out in KEYS Policies even when I do not immediately understand the purpose behind them. In all other situations, I will use common sense.
